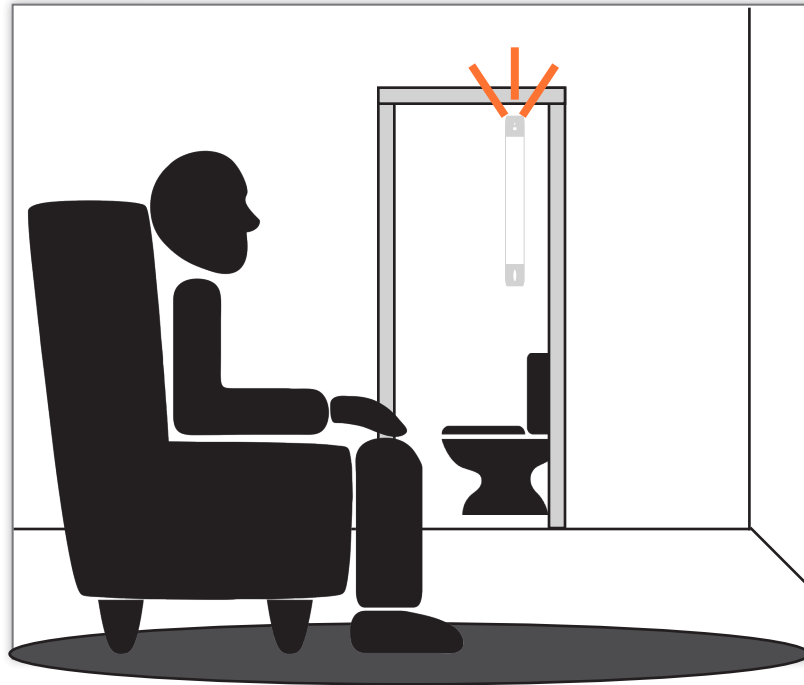
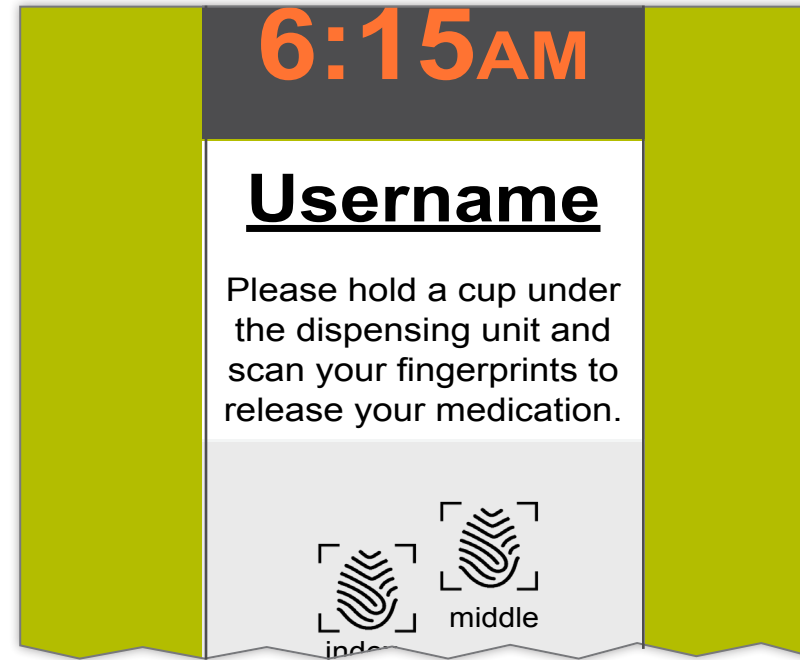


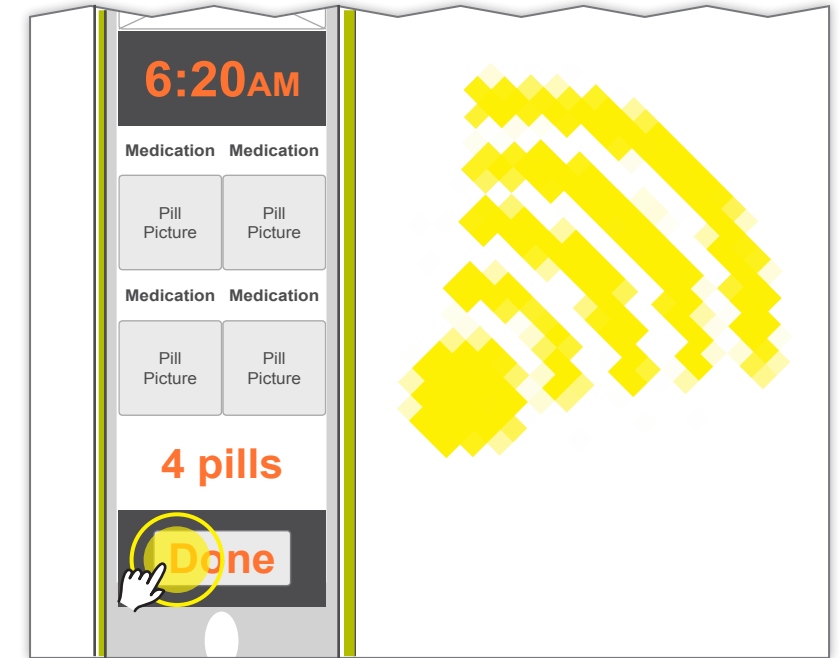
*User Receives alert to take medication, takes medication, and caregiver watches video that medicine was taken.*



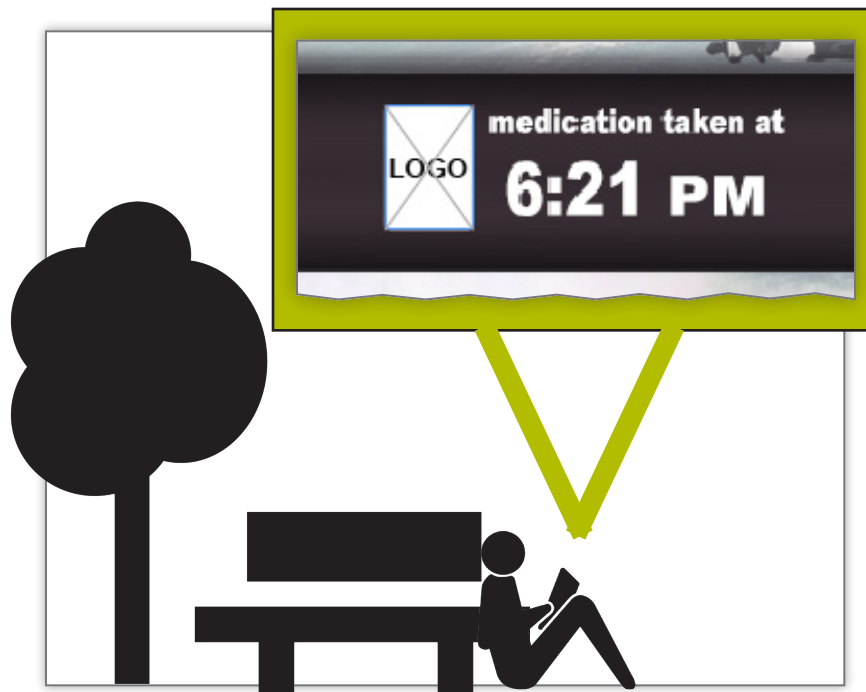
1. The unit holding medication is mounted on the wall in the bathroom. The user hears a beep to remind him that it is time to take medication.



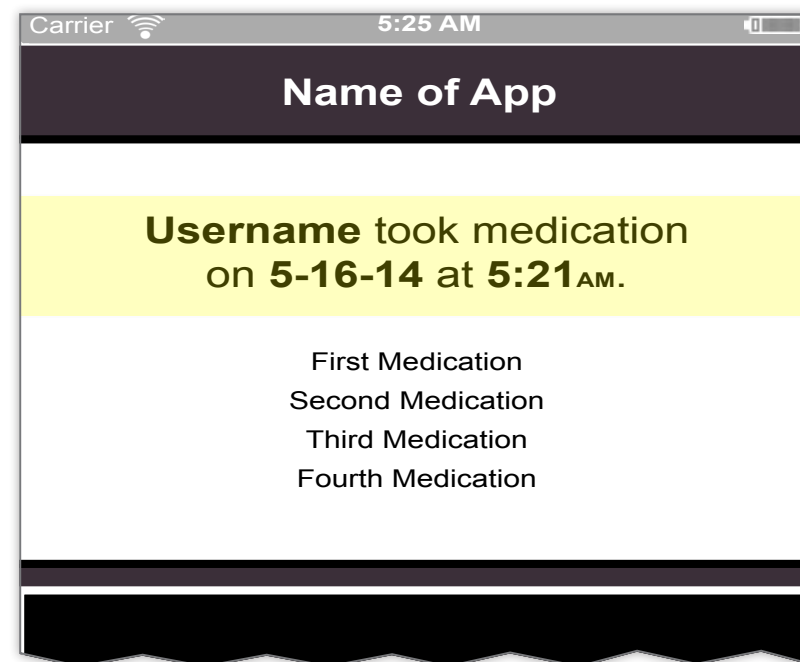
2. The unit verifies the user's identity via fingerprint recognition. There is also a sensor below the machine to detect a cup to catch pills.



3. When the user presses "Done," the machine sends a notification to the caregiver via the app. This includes a video of the user actually taking the medication (video camera is the white dot).



4. As long as the caregiver is connected via wifi or other data means, he/she will receive a notification that medicine has been taken as scheduled.



5. A more detailed notification is accessed through an alert on the phone's home screen. Date, time, a list of medicines taken...



6. and a video of the caregiver's loved one taking medicines as scheduled bring peace of mind to all.
